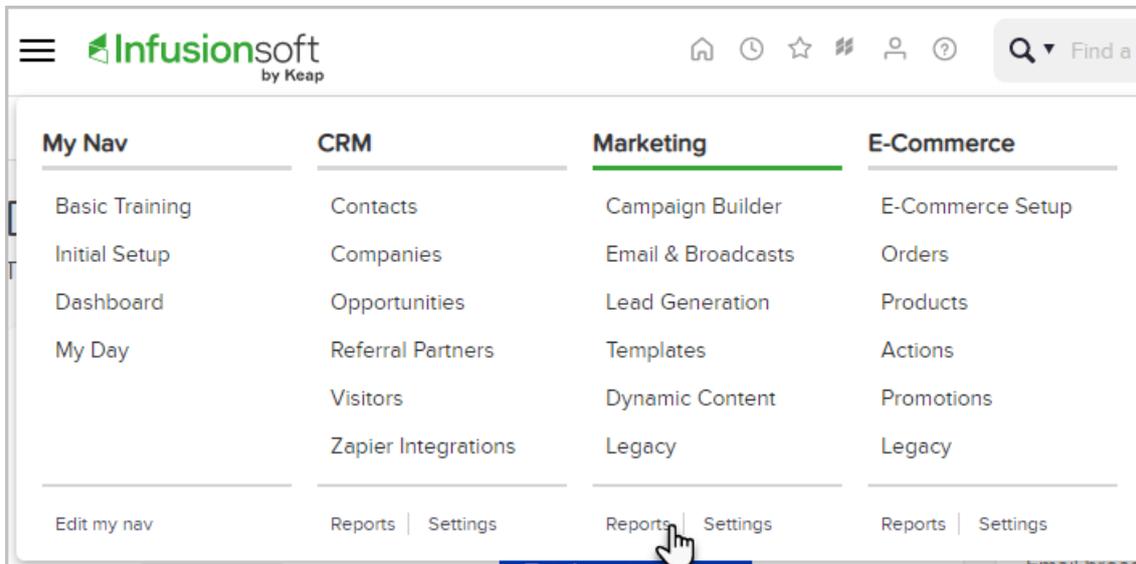


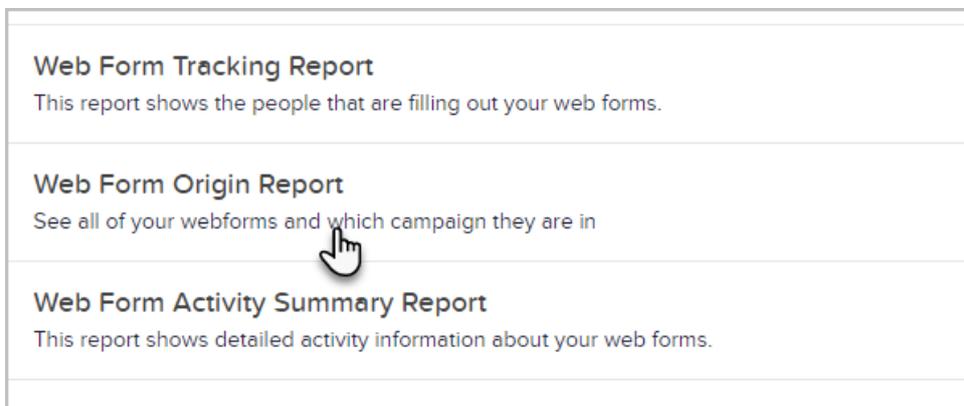
Web Form Origin Report

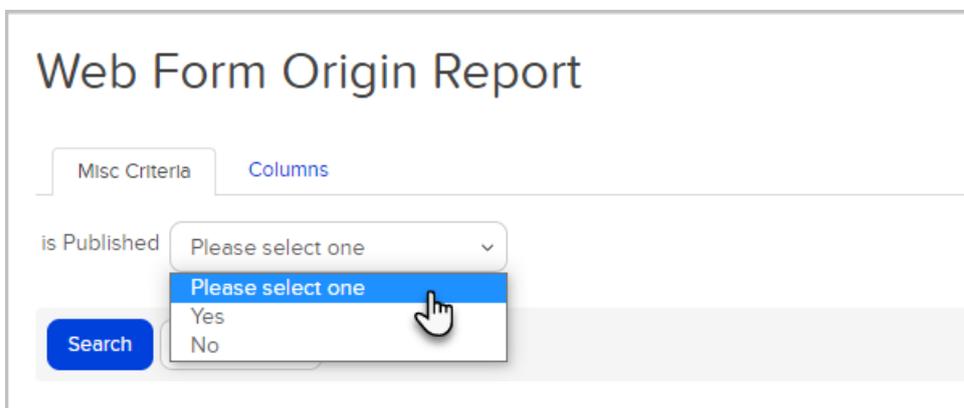
1. Navigate to Marketing > Reports



2. Click **Web Form Origin Report**



3. Choose to search for published or unpublished web forms



4. (Optional) Click **Columns** to modify how your report will be presented and sorted
